Special Conditions for Great Pacific Hotels Pte Limited Holder of Permit Number WDP W42-2024/2025

Requirements for Permits

Regulation 3(1) states "A facility is liable for prosecution for an offence under Part 6 of the Act if-

- (a) It requires a permit under these Regulations and undertakes any regulated activity on or from its premises or a vehicle under its control without a permit;
- (b) It holds a permit under these Regulations but undertakes a regulated activity from its premises or a vehicle under its control in breach of the conditions of the permit;
- (c) It is exempted from the requirement for a permit under these Regulations but undertakes a regulated activity from its premises or a vehicle under its control in breach of the conditions of the exemption."

Solid Waste Permit Conditions

- 1. This permit covers the following solid wastes that Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd produces: packaging waste, bottle wrappers, plastics, damaged PET bottles and general solid waste.
- 2. Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must minimize and reuse solid waste generated by the facility and divert all recyclable solid wastes to a Department of Environment registered waste recycler.
- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must ensure that all non-recyclable and residual solid wastes are
 collected by a Department of Environment registered waste transport company and disposed of
 at a Department of Environment approved disposal site.

Liquid Waste Permit Conditions

- 1. Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must not discharge any untreated wastewater into the environment.
- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must comply with the National Liquid Waste Standards as stipulated in Schedule 3 of the Environment Management (Waste Disposal and Recycling) Regulations 2007.
- 3. Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must ensure that the discharge of uncontaminated mains water, rainwater or storm water from the premises is in compliance with the National Liquid Waste Standards as stipulated under Schedule 3 of the Environment Management (Waste Disposal and Recycling) Regulations 2007.

Air Pollution Permit Conditions

- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must ensure that all emissions from the facility comply with the National Air Quality Standards as stipulated under Schedule 5 of the Environment Management (Waste Disposal and Recycling) Regulations 2007.
- 2. Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must manage all dust emitting activities and areas to control emissions within the facility.
- 3. Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must not undertake incineration or open burning of facility waste.

Hazardous Waste Endorsement

- 1. Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must ensure that all hazardous substances are properly handled, stored, transported and disposed of in a manner that will not affect the natural environment.
- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must ensure that its employees are trained on the transportation, storage and handling of hazardous substances or hazardous waste within and outside of the facility.
- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must maintain the material safety data sheets highlighting proper handling, storage, transportation and environmentally sound disposal of all hazardous substances purchased.
- 4. Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must document spill response and containment procedures for all hazardous substances and wastes kept or produced by the facility.
- 5. Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must provide spill kits and spill containment equipment for use

with accidental spills of waste oil, diesel fuel and ensure that all staff are trained on the correct use of spill kits and spill containment equipment.

General Provisions

- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must allow the Director of Environment or any officer authorized by the Director of Environment to have access to the premises of the facility at any reasonable time, with or without notice, in order to inspect them for compliance with the permit conditions.
- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must allow the Director of Environment or any officer authorized by the Director of Environment to take photographs and films, make drawings or take samples in accordance with the Environment Management (Waste Disposal and Recycling) Regulations 2007.
- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd will not undertake any regulated activity at any time except as permitted by the permit.
- 4. All waste generated by Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd is encouraged to be minimized through the practice of 7R (rethink, refuse, reduce, repurpose, reuse, recycle and recover) concept.
- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must ensure that a register is maintained at the facility in respect of all regulated activity to which the permit relates and made available to the WPC Administrator and an inspector at any reasonable time.
- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must take all reasonable steps to ensure that the Safety and Health at Work Act is complied with by all persons on the premises, both as regards to personal safety and the handling of hazardous substances.
- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must submit Waste Disposal Returns in writing under Form (4) as set out in the Regulations and sent to the Department of Environment every 12 months from the effective date of this permit.
- 8. Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must report incidents relating to any accidental discharge/disposal/emissions of wastes and pollutants the Department no less than 24hrs from the time of the incident.
- Great Pacific Hotels Pte Ltd must obtain all necessary approvals and permits. This permit
 approval does not relieve the facility of other legal requirements under the Environment
 Management Act 2005, Environment Management (Waste Disposal and Recycling) Regulation
 2007 and Environment Management (EIA Process) Regulations 2007 and other Acts and
 legislation.

If the facility is dissatisfied with the conditions to the Waste Disposal Permit, the facility may within 10 days from the date of being notified of the decision, appeal in writing to the Permanent Secretary.

Breach of any of the conditions will result in cancellation of the Permit with immediate effect and appropriate action under Environment Management Act 2005 and the Environment Management (Waste Disposal and Recycling) Regulations 2007.
